Introduction

Welcome to the International Breast Ultrasound Course taking place in co-operation with the Reference Centre for Mammography, University of Muenster.

The city of Muenster, Germany is the site of the International Breast Ultrasound Course which has become an acknowledged forum for radiologists, gynaecologists and other specialists working in the field of clinical breast diagnosis as well as mammographic screening.

During the two days "Introductory Level" and the two days "Advanced Level" programme, we will concentrate on the following subjects:

April 27th – basics of breast ultrasound and standardized examination techniques

April 28th – multimodality imaging and histopathological correlation

April 29th – diagnostic criteria, assessment, biopsy techniques

April 30th – advances application of ultrasound, multimodality training, updates

Lectures will focus on standardized decision making, assessment, and histopathological correlation of especially small, screen-detected cancers. The workshops will include the use of mammographic, ultrasound and MRI methods to be presented as an integrated teaching session combined with practical experiences.

The International Breast Ultrasound School (IBUS) is the leading international provider of high-quality breast ultrasound education, and each year conducts an intensive course with the University of Ferrara in Italy. This first course in Muenster is based on the "Ferrara model", and the University of Muenster will join with the University of Ferrara in forming a "university-based consortium" to provide quality courses with uniform standards to satisfy international CME requirements.

The course venue will be the Mövenpick Hotel, a modern hotel close to the Lake Aa and the city centre. The technical exhibition will feature state of the art ultrasound equipment.

You are invited to the course banquets which are included in the registration fee, and these will be held on Monday evening at the Park-Hotel Schloss Hohenfeld and on Wednesday evening at the Schloss Wilkinghege. On Tuesday, we will offer a guided city tour as an optional extra.

Furthermore, the course will allow us once again to meet colleagues and discuss common problems in both formal and informal settings, and extend our knowledge in breast ultrasound. Continuing Medical Education (CME) credits will be given to participating physicians.

We are looking forward to welcoming you in Muenster!

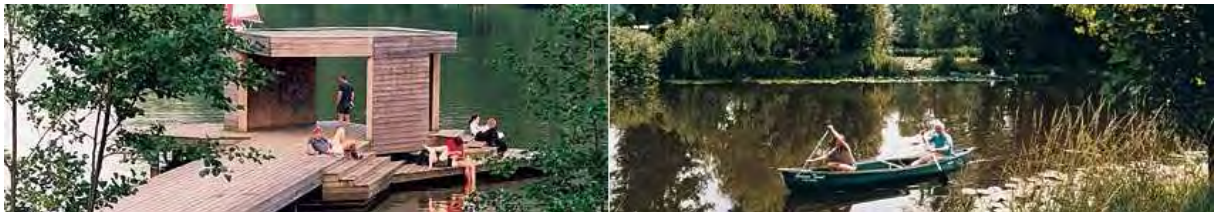
Welcome to Muenster

It is also possible to hire rowing boats and pedalos at the lake. The eye-catching Giant Pool Balls, three enormous concrete billiard balls created by Claes Oldenburg on the occasion of the first sculpture exhibition in 1977, grace the lake's northern banks. Lake Aa is also a popular location for events.

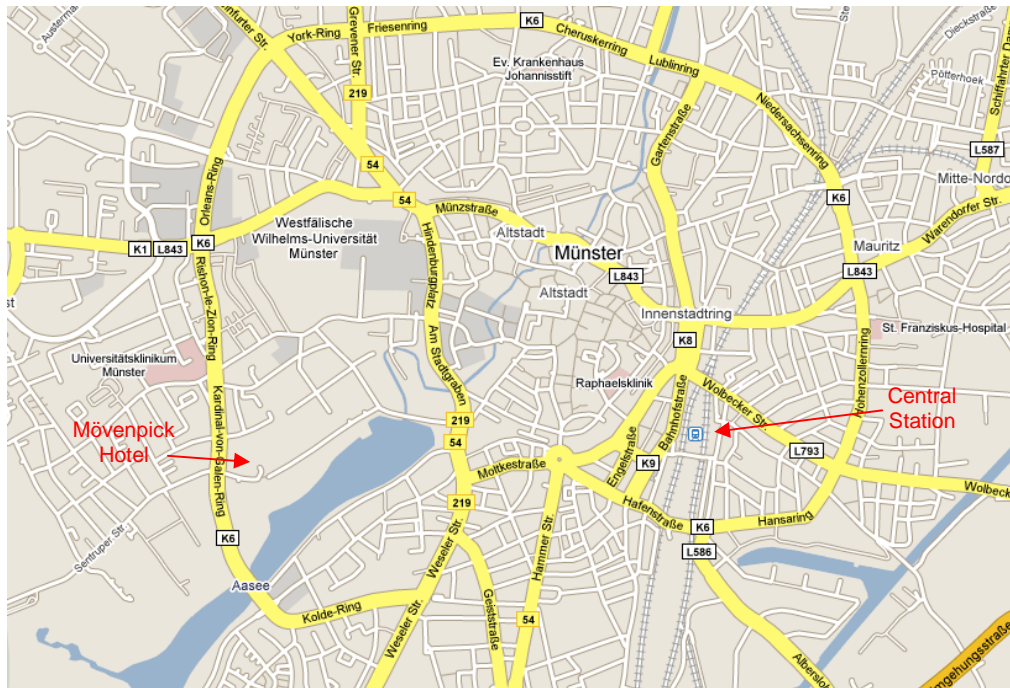
